Installing the Deprecated HTML report

- 1. Download the **DeprecatedHTMLReport.zip** file from the downloads section of this article.
- 2. Extract the contents of the zip file.
- 3. Navigate to the \scripts\database directory where database is DB2, MSSQL, or Oracle.
- 4. Run the **PC_PEGAECS_DEPRECATEDREPORT.sql** script to create the **DeprecatedHTMLReport_6.x** RAP file.
- 5. Use the package import wizard to import the **DeprecatedHTMLReport_6.x** RAP file.
 - a. Log on to PRPC as an administrator.
 - b. Click **Pega > Application > Import and Export > Package** to open the import wizard.
 - c. Select Check Compile Libraries.
 - d. Run the import wizard.
- 6. Add the report ruleset to your application ruleset:
 - a. Open the profile menu, and click **Application**.
 - b. Add the *PegaECS-UpgradeUtilities-HTML5:06-0x* ruleset to the top of application ruleset list.
- 7. Log out and log back in to the application.

Because this task overrides the Designer Studio landing page, you cannot view the custom landing page of your application until the ruleset is removed.

Identifying deprecated HTML code

- 1. After you log back in, click **Pega > Deprecated HTML Report**.
- 2. Click **Generate Report**. The report lists all the rules that use deprecated HTML tags and the total number of deprecated tags and attributes in the code.
- 3. Expand each rule to view deprecated tags and attributes, and common alternatives.

- 4. Review the results and update the rules as required.
- 5. Optional. Click **Export to Excel** to export the results to a Microsoft Excel workbook.

Uninstalling the report

Uninstall the report by removing the *PegaECS-UpgradeUtilities-HTML5:06-0x* rule from your application ruleset.

Remove the ruleset from the application landing page. Open the profile menu and click **Application** to access the application landing page.
